The government is increasingly swaying

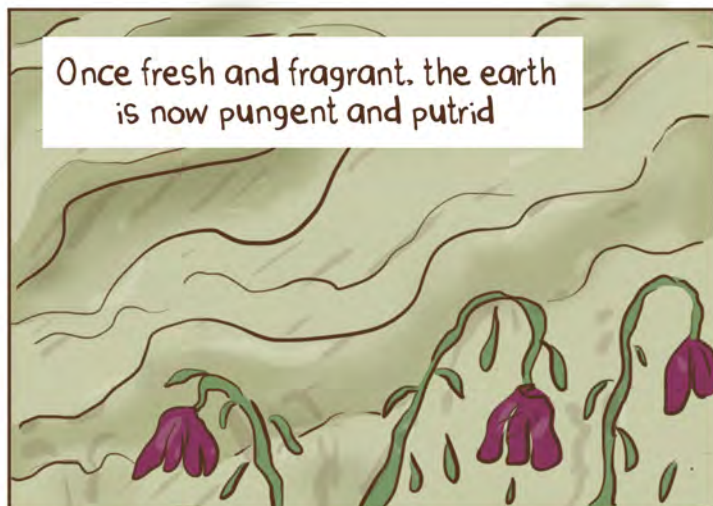


Shaking and trembling

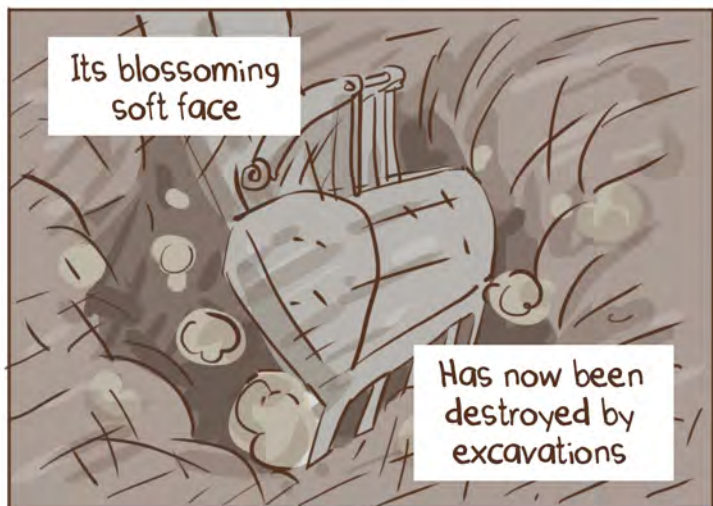


The earth where they stood upon while building their glory has refused to bow to their will

disturbing the rulers

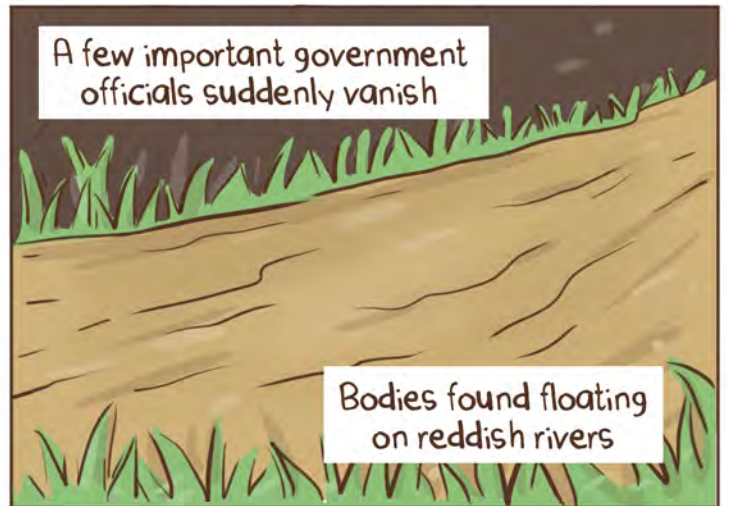
The fiery urge to blame one

were damaged

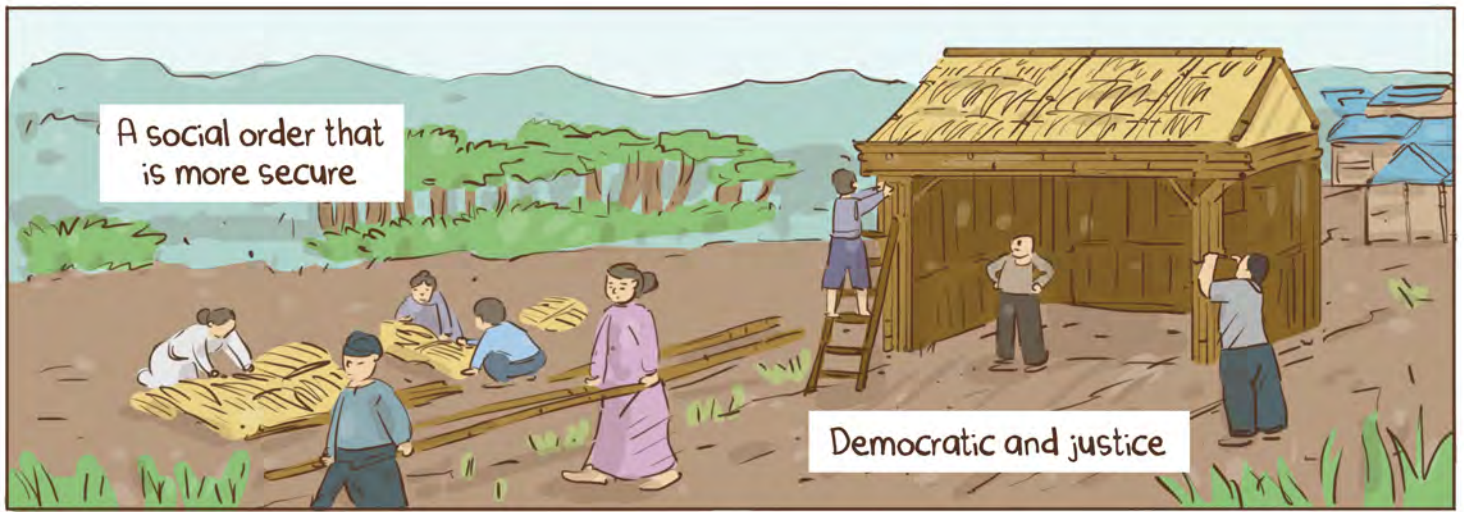
Since there are no

Inside the cells, we experienced violence over and over again

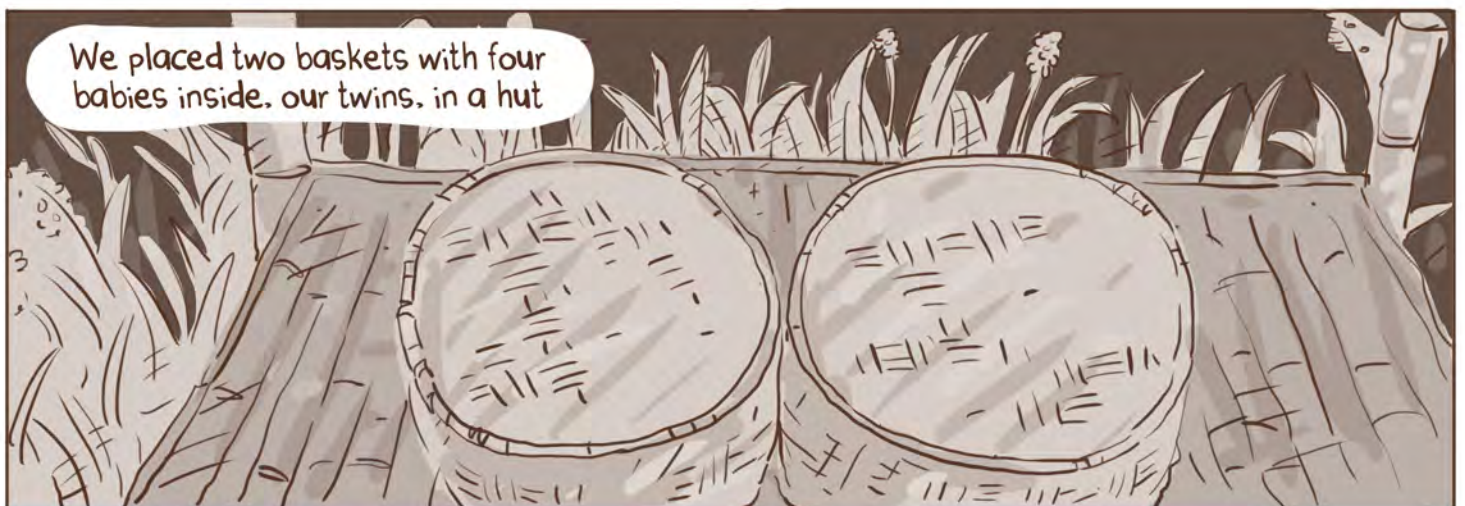


Until one day we became pregnant

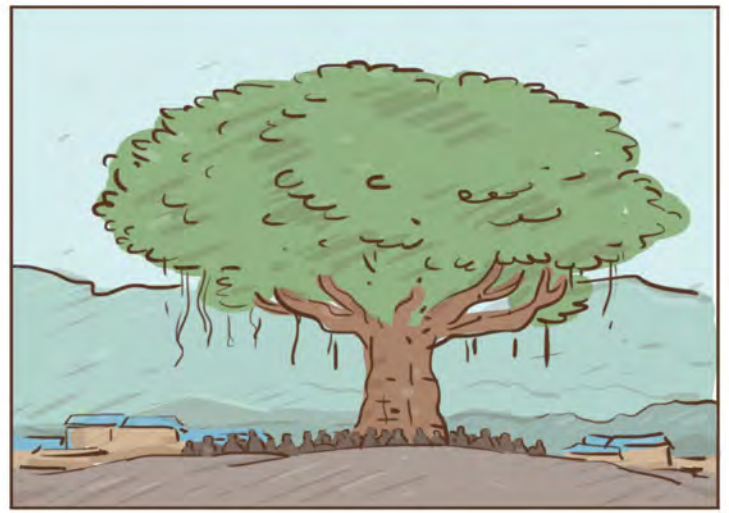
Later in our pregnancies, we managed to escape

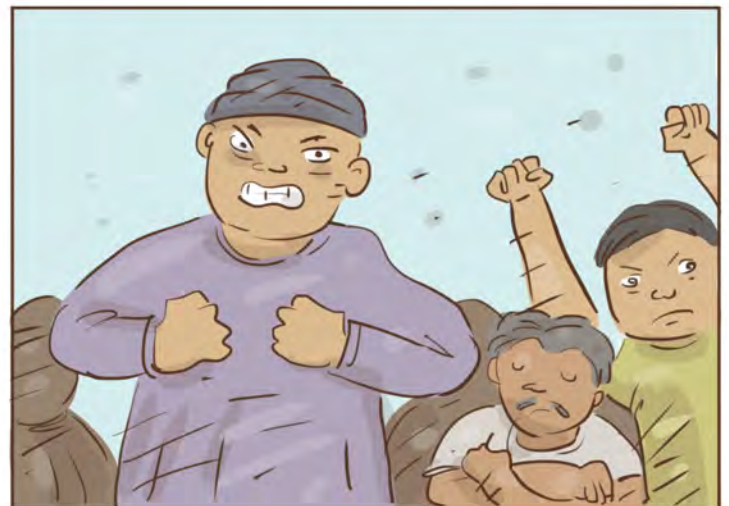
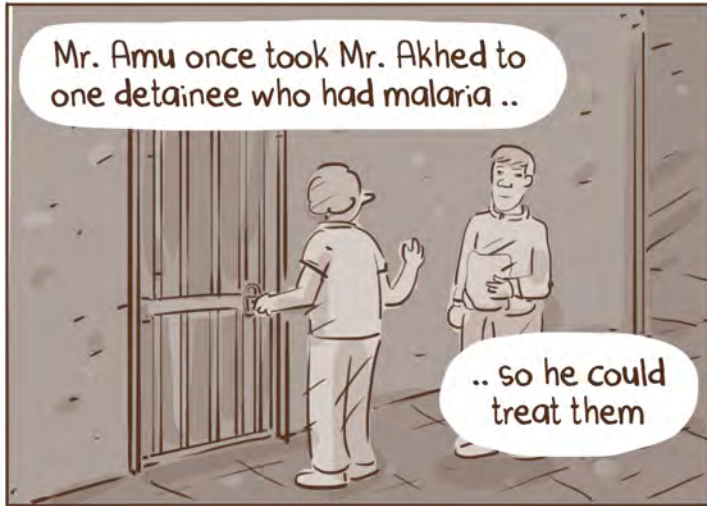


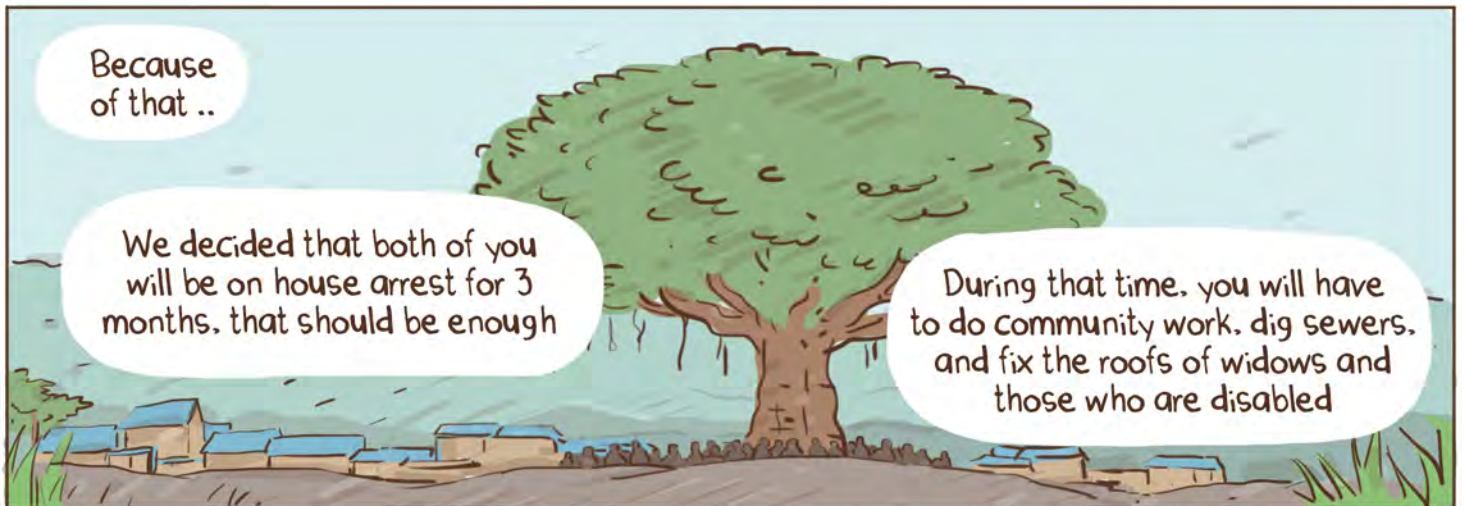
And gave birth at a small clinic by the village

Exploring existing economic models that has been applied in other countries

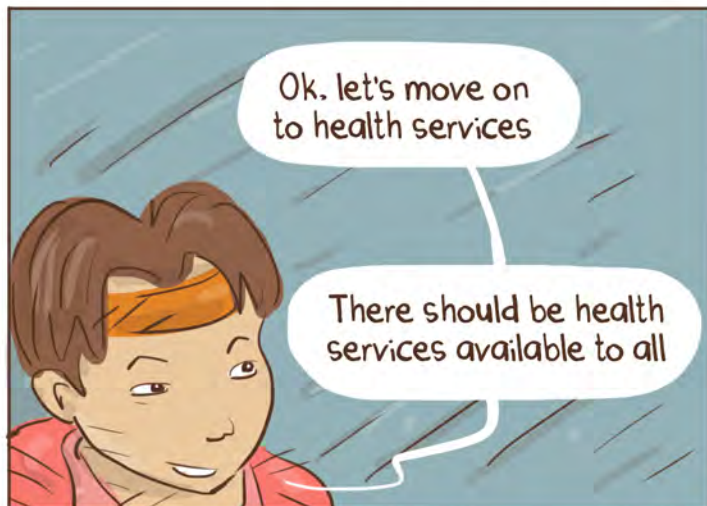
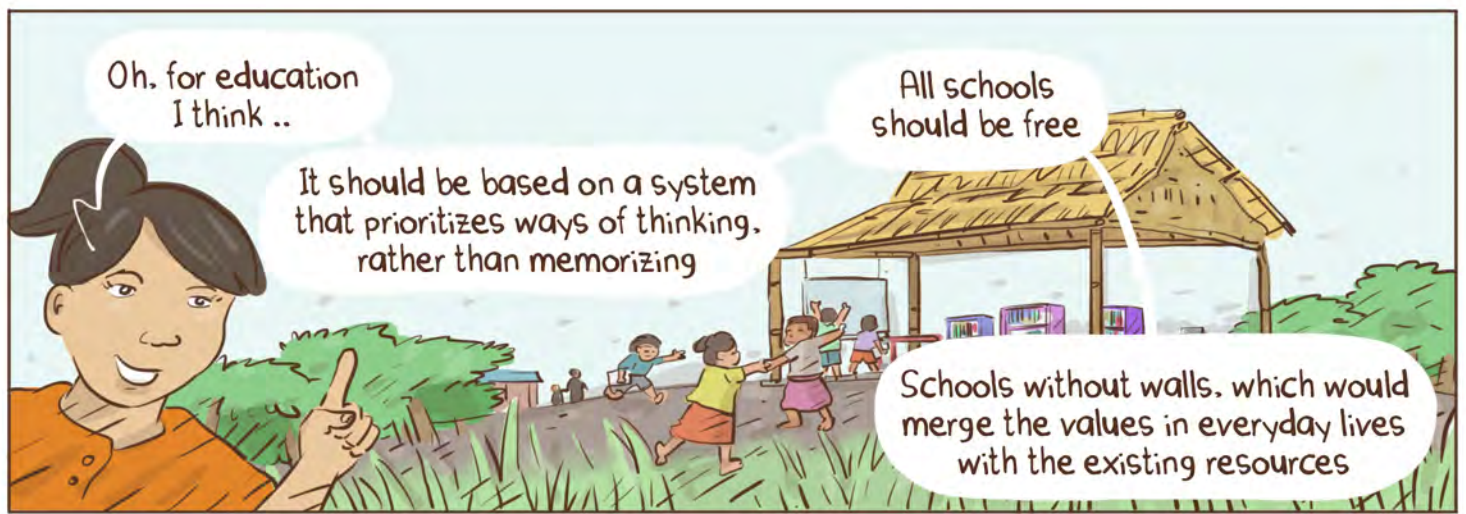
They agreed to build an economic system that balances the distribution of profit among shareholders and workers
